Cedarfield Plantation Board Meeting Minutes for 3-11-2014

Attendance: Julie Taylor, Dave Rosen, William Saran, Gigi Glass, Margaret Doherty, Barrie Rojahn (Hawthorne Mgmt)
Meeting called to order at 7:05pm and meeting was adjourned at 8:45pm.

Treasury / Financial Report:

The 2014 Board reviewed the financial statement for February 2014 and the 2014 budget. The Board agreed on a Collection Policy for 2014. The Board reviewed outstanding items and will prioritize as needed based on the budget.

Completed Projects:

An arborist with Heartwood collected soil samples from the oak trees located along the pool house drive. The soil analysis should be completed within 3 weeks.

Outstanding Items:

The Board met with the Town of Huntersville to review the plan for the damaged grass areas at the main front entrance (McCoy Rd. and Stratton Farm Rd.). The Town of Huntersville will make modifications to the front grass areas on both sides of the road to improve drainage from McCoy Rd/Stratton Farm to the pool house drive.

The Board is reviewing a Spring Informational letter to be sent to all homeowners.

The Board approved a bid to change all light fixtures at entrance monuments to more energy efficient light fixtures and place accent lighting along the landscaping at front entrance (McCoy/Stratton Farm down to the pool house drive).

The Board agreed to design new signs to be placed in all marquee locations.

The Board will review the pool fob list to ensure accuracy for the 2014 pool season.

The Board will research adding additional cameras at the pool area and replacing the outdated pool fob system.

The Board approved adding lights along the pool house drive through the Energy United lighting program.

The Board discussed replacing the trees along the pool house drive.

The Welcome Committee will create a "Welcome Packet" for all new homeowners in Cedarfield.

An analysis of the irrigation system is currently in progress. We will start on the repairs once the analysis is complete. The Board members assigned to the Pool Committee will meet with Cedarfield 2 to review / standardize our pool policies.

The Board will research options for WIFI at the pool area and will look to possibly integrate other Media/Music solutions.

Next Meeting, April 9th at 7pm at the CI Pool.

Mowing season is about to begin! Most of us have Tall Fescue lawns and this type grass should be kept at 2 1/2 to 3 1/2 inches so don't forget to raise your mower blade! Mowing down too much, allows sun and weeds to damage the roots. Please remember to keep your lawn edged at all curbs and sidewalks. Also, remember that weeds spread...they will spread into your neighbor's lawn, so please keep them under control. Here are tips on fertilizing and caring for a [Tall Fescue lawn](#).

The meeting was called to order at 7:09 PM and the previous Minutes were adopted.

President's Report - Our **President, Emily Biggs** has announced her departure from the Board, effective immediately. It is with great regard for Emily's interest, volunteerism and professional handling of Board matters that we know that she will be missed. *Our heartfelt THANK YOU goes out to her.*

Hawthorne Mgmts. report - **Barrie** reviewed the rules and procedures for placement of Liens on properties and the Foreclosure process as we are reviewing some properties now for future action. // The question raised last month as to the Budget line item showing a negative balance in our reserves for Pool Resurface has been explained as being a deterrent to not just move positive balances around just to make the account a positive figure. This means that we preserve the accuracy of each Budget Reserve Account balance and deal with funding any Reserve that needs attention. There is a Cash Balance on hand that is sufficient to mitigate that negative but is not a necessary cause for concern or action just because we show it to be negative on the Budget.

Treasurer's report - Our newly appointed **Treasurer, Michael Rumble**, has a spreadsheet of future needs that will be tracked to determine if special consideration will be needed to fund those needs and wants. This will be discussed at future Board Meetings.

Committee reports

Pool - **Kevin** asked the Board to consider raising the Insurance coverage for the Playground, Pool House and Pool Equipment. Hawthorne responded with a quote from our current Insurance provider. More investigation will be necessary to determine if additional quotes

from other providers will be necessary. // Protective drain covers to meet the new VGB requirements have been paid for and they will be installed prior to opening the Pool.

Landscape - New **Rain Detector Timers** for the entry sprinkler systems are being installed and Repellants for protection of plantings from deer have been authorized. **Pine Needles**, potential trimming or removal of the large holly bushes by the pool fence, removal of trees by the Pool lighting and planting of decorative ferns or rose bushes for the pool surroundings are being provided by our landscape contractor. // The balance of **Split Rail Fencing** will also be removed and that directive will apply to all existing fencing remaining in CII as a means to freshen up the look of our community.

Social - **Jennifer** and **Joanne** are processing the **Easter** community event. // Also upcoming is the community **Yard Sale**. Watch for announcements for the date.

ARC - **Suzanne** and **Gary** have the task of approving the requests for building projects. With Spring approaching, many projects are anticipated. REMEMBER, a request for installation of new Fencing, Sheds, changes of House Paint or Shingle colors MUST be submitted for approval PRIOR to any work commencing. The goal is to maintain a "harmonious" and "consistent" appearance in the C-Two neighborhood as well as requiring owners to maintain their property for the ongoing value that is added by proper upkeep.

have been moved up and will be June 28.

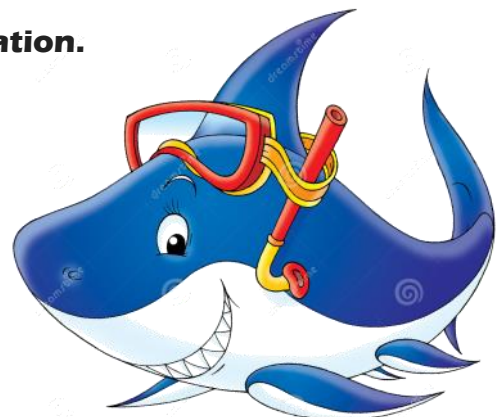

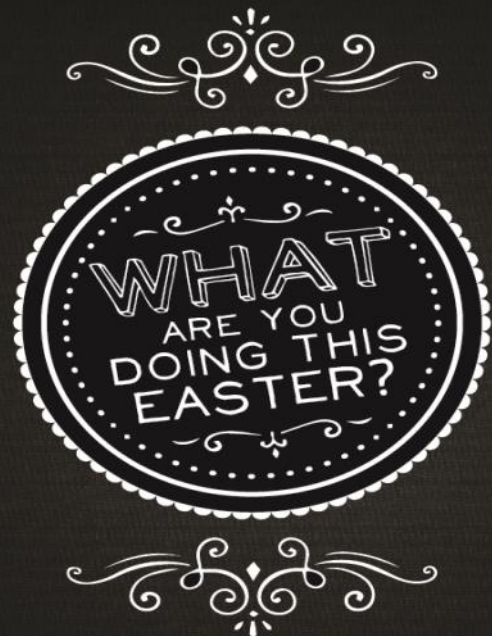
