Safety reminders for Cedarfield

Recently Cedarfield has been experiencing • some vandalism and vehicle theft issues.

According to the Huntersville Police, this is not unusual for this time of year. The majority of our issues are products of kids • with too much time (and freedom) on their hands! Protect yourself with a few useful tips:

 Huntersville has a curfew. Children 12 and under 10pm. Teens up to 15 years old—11pm. If you see any teens or younger children out and about past 11pm call 911. Even if you don't think it is an emergency... they should not be out after 11pm and the police will ensure they are returned home safely.

- Lock your cars at night. 84% of all vehicle break-ins were not break-ins at all...the vehicle was unlocked.
- Remove GPS devices, laptops, cameras, ipods, or anything else of value from your car. If you can't afford to lose it, don't leave it.
- Turn on your porch lights, front and back yard. Use landscape lighting which not only enhances the beauty of your home but helps us light up the area so that if someone is prowling around your property they can be seen.



Social Committee / Monthly Events:

Provided budget update as well as information on pending events throughout the year. The Board agreed to run all events through the Social Committee and provide a 2 weeks notice on all events scheduled through the remainder of the year by signage or mailing. A mailing was sent out for the upcoming Adult Pool Party.

Adult Pool Party - Scheduled for July. Upcoming events from the Social Committe Labor Day, Pool Closing Party and Halloween Party. Panthers Opening Day Party was discussed, pending additional information.

Safety reminders for Cedarfield..continued

- Contact the Huntersville Police if you will be out of town on vacation, or if your spouse is traveling and you just want that extra security, by filling out a Security Check Form. You can click this box or go to www.huntersvillepd.org under Forms and Applications it is called a **Security Check Request** Form. The HPD will make regular checks on your property throughout the day and night. Will ensure no one but those you've designated to pet sit, take in your mail, etc... are hanging around your property. This is a great FREE service!
- If you see ANYONE suspicious in the neighborhood, call 911. Even they don't appear to be posing a threat, if they don't look like they belong, call 911. Don't wait for them to break into a neighbors house or car before you call the police.
- Take the time to copy down serial numbers and take photos of items you own...anything of value. If it doesn't have a serial number then purchase an inexpensive engraver and put your own name or DL # on the item. If anything of yours is stolen this is the only way the police can recover it. (Keep the photos of your items on a flash drive and lock that up. Don't leave the photos on your camera because if your camera is stolen....)
- Keep your trees and bushes trimmed so that there is a clean sight line in yards and sidewalk areas. This provides less cover for someone snooping around who shouldn't be there.
 - If an abandoned or foreclosed home is being neglected on your street, report it to the town of Huntersville

www.huntersville.org Over-

grown lawns and bushes are a code violation and the city will take care of it for you. Don't try to maintain it yourself as it is private property and it could be seen as trespassing. But don't ignore it! It is more than an eyesore...it is a safety issue as well.

FYI: Cedarfield's crime rate is actually down from last year and the vandalism is pretty much just juvenile delinquent kinda stuff...so keep in mind that it is still a fantastic neighborhood. Keep an eye out for your neighbors, get to know your neighbors. Host a block party and make sure you know who comes and goes on your street. CALL 911 when you feel like someone doesn't belong or is posing a danger/threat. Call 911 if you see kids climbing the DUKE Towers, (this is dangerous and illegal). Most importantly, lock your vehicle doors and be smart about safety.

nyone else noticing that all this rain has really green'd up our lawns and trees this summer? Everything looks beautiful compared to hot dry summers of the past! Unfortunately it also makes keeping up with our lawn maintenance a lot harder! Some residents are not edging their lawns and it is really starting to stand out... Nothing makes a neighborhood look "aged" and old like grass and weeds growing up over the sidewalks, into the streets, in cracks, etc.

Please edge your lawn along the streets and sidewalks. Sweep or blow your lawn clippings rather than just leaving them and try to

control your weeds so that your weed problem doesn't become your neighbors weed problem too!





The Board is researching pricing to change all light fixtures at entrance monuments to more energy efficient light fixtures.

The Board agreed to repair or replace tables in pool area along south side parking area, this item is in progress

Bike Rack near pool area needs to be repaired; homeowner in the neighborhood will help with repair.

New Items:

We have an IT Specialist completing an analysis of the website to identify all issues. We will work with the current website provider to fix all outstanding issues. The Board agreed to meet with the website provider to discuss all options available for the website and provide training for the administrators.

Pool / Landscaping:

A motion was made and voted in favor to contract a licensed irrigation company. The company will evaluate systems for future upgrade to all sites to improve plantings and neighborhood beautification.

The Board was presented with two positions for re-election - President and Secretary. Phil Hoffman was nominated and accepted the position of Board President. Sandy Thiry was nominated and accepted the position of Secretary.

Community Awareness:

Huntersville Police Dept. Sgt. Seifert addressed the concerns over recent vandalism throughout all of the Cedarfield Association neighborhoods. A community wide security meeting is scheduled for Monday, July 29th, 7PM, at the C-2 community pool.

Residents should call 911to report any suspicious persons or activity in their neighborhood. Also, residents are reminded to keep garage doors and vehicles closed and locked at all times as thefts for these areas only take seconds.

Parents are asked to remind their children who skateboard on streets to obey the rules of the road and although they are not required to wear helmets to behavior in a safe and responsible manner.

Good & Welfare:

July Yard of the Month was presented to the residents of 12718 Green Ashe Dr. The last award of the season will be given out in August- it could be you! Thanks to all our residents for maintaining their yards!

Pool:

The pool received a surprise inspection from the Health Dept. We are happy to announce the only violation found was the flotation rescue device had a crack in it and has now been replaced. The pool is now again in full operation mode.

Some grouting around the pool tiles has come loose and will need to be repaired. Therefore, the pool will be closed for approximately 2 days to accomplish this. As soon as the repair date is scheduled a notice of closure will be posted at the pool. We apologize for the inconvenience.

Other Business:

The playground mulch keeps washing away with all the heavy rain we have had this summer. The Board will need to review this area in the fall and determine what changes can be made to correct this issue.

The Board will address, at a later date, some major renovations/projects; 1.Tennis court foundation.
