



Cedarfield Plantation (C1) Monthly Board Meeting - July 8, 2014

Meeting called to order at 7pm and meeting was adjourned at 8:40pm. (Next Meeting: August 12th at the pool)

Treasury / Financial Report:

Hawthorne Management provided an overview of the May Financial Statement / update of the delinquencies/violations reports.

Social Committee:

The Board discussed updates to the remaining events for 2014 with the departure of members on the Social Committee. Margaret and Gigi will lead the effort until we have filled openings on the Social Committee.

Completed Projects / Items:

Pruning of the trees down the pool house drive has been completed.

Two lights on the inside of the pool area have been repaired by our contractor.

Outstanding Items:

The Board approved funds to add mulch to the playground area; installation will begin within 2 weeks.

The Board approved funds to have all monuments cleaned and lettering painted.

Repairs to the irrigation system are currently in progress by the Landscape Company.

The addition of small trees on the left side of Stratton Farm is pending due to the delay of the irrigation repairs. The repair to the irrigation system damaged during the installation of the pool house drive lighting is pending.

Pruning of the trees at Twin Trail Island and at pond area are pending; the work should be completed within 2 weeks.

The fertilizer treatment for the oak trees down the pool house drive by the Landscape Company is pending.

The Board agreed to design new generic signs to be placed in all marguee locations when needed.

The Board is in discussions to move the marquee boards in the island of Twin Trail and Bradford Hill to a more visible area.

The Board will research adding new signs at pool and pond area.

The Welcome Committee is in progress to create a "Welcome Packet" for all new homeowners in Cedarfield.

Pool House Project: items in progress

The Board is working with the Town of Huntersville and Mecklenburg County to determine items needed to obtain permits for the possible remodel of the pool house.

The Board will create a Statement of Work to aid with the possible pool house remodel and meet with potential contractors.
