#### Cedarfield II HOA Board Meeting Minutes—Jan. 14, 2013

Attending: President: Emily Biggs; Vice President: Kevin LaValley; Members-at-Large: William Carter; Gary Wilt; Secretary-Treasurer: Ray Kudlak; Barrie Rojahns, Hawthorne Management. Copies to Kevin and Jennifer Wolfe, Social Committee.

The meeting was called to order at 7:07 PM and the previous Minutes were adopted. There were insufficient homeowners present to represent a quorum of 41 households.

<u>Treasurer's report</u> – A review of **fiscal 2012** was presented by Barrie Rojahns and the previously published and distributed 2013 Budget was adopted.

<u>Committee</u> reports - A summary of projects completed in 2012 was presented. Each Committee recapped the accomplishments undertaken for our Pool and Pool House, Parking Lot, Landscaping including Entrance Lighting and Sprinklers, Pool Parties and Annual Social Events. More emphasis will be placed on social events in 2013 due to suggestions received and an expanded budget.

<u>Major Accomplishments</u> – include new Pool Covers, Striping the Parking Lot Spaces, new Lifeguard Chairs, Re-strapped and new Pool Furniture, new Umbrellas, new Water Fountain, new Pool House A/C motor, new Sand Filter for the Baby Pool, Pine Needles spread on entire C2 Common Property, new Playground Mulch, major Trimming of Bushes and Trees, replacing lighting at entrances where needed, new designs for plantings provided by our new landscape contractor.

<u>Old Business</u> – The question regarding on-street parking was discussed with participation of the Board, Hawthorne's representative and attending Cedarfield residents. Many opinions were voiced, questions raised and definitive answers given based on past Legal Reviews and meetings with local government officials.

<u>New Business</u> – A new Cedarfield Web Site is coming in 2013 and will include log-in access for Cedarfield members. Also, the Cedarfield Sun will now be produced by Catherine Greenberg and will appear on the Web Site and in printed form by request. 

#### What the Architectural Committee Does for You (ARC)

Are you getting ready to make an addition to your house or build a new shed or fence in your back yard? Before you break out the miter saw, make sure to get your plans approved by our association's architectural committee.

While it may seem arbitrary from an individual homeowner's standpoint, the architectural committee looks out for the entire community. Aside from stopping residents from painting pink polka dots on their houses, the committee's job is to make sure that the size and style of the project, the type of building materials being used and the overall look of the new structure adhere to the association's design requirements. Not only does this keep the community looking cohesive, it also helps to keep property values up by preventing individual structures from standing out. Of course, it's also important to note that unapproved structures might legally have to be removed at the owner's expense, so save yourself money and headaches by getting approval before building.

So when you're ready to start your new project, or if the design of your project changes midway through building it, send your plans to the architectural committee first so that we can make sure they're in compliance with the association's design standards. If we do find any issues, we'll let you know what they are and try to help you come up with other options. We appreciate all the hard work residents have done to make their homes and this community beautiful—help us keep this association looking great by keeping us in the loop of all your building projects.

### Cedarfield Park Board Meeting Minutes — January 2013

#### Know the Rules

Have you checked out the HOA's covenants, conditions and restrictions (CC&Rs) lately? If not, now's a great time to brush up on the do's and don'ts of the community.

For those of you who were unaware, CC&Rs play a crucial role in keeping the association running smoothly. CC&Rs are legally binding rules and regulations that each homeowner agrees to when he or she purchases a unit within the association. If owners rent out their homes, it's the owner's responsibility to inform the new residents of the bylaws as well. CC&Rs include stipulations on assessments, building design and additions, and the governance of the association. All residents need to understand these CC&Rs so they don't unintentionally violate them; owners can be fined by the association and—in extreme cases—sued for violating the CC&Rs. Owners are empowered when they understand the CC&Rs and the procedures for changing or amending them when they are no longer applicable or relevant to the community.

While they may seem arbitrary, the CC&Rs are legally enforceable. They also help ensure the association as a whole can thrive and that members are treated fairly and equally. So don't be left in the dark—check out the association's CC&Rs today!

If you don't have a copy of the CC&Rs, please call Hawthorne Management or visit your community website.

Parents of teens who skateboard: On any given day you can visit the CI or CII facebook pages and see someone sharing how they came very close to hitting (or being hit by) someone riding a skateboard in Cedarfield. Please talk with your teens about safety.

Here are some concerns people have shared:

Riding down the middle of the road and not moving for on-coming traffic.

Darting across intersections without care for cross traffic.

Riding in the street after dark wearing dark clothing making them virtually invisible.

Just a quick note: According to Skaters for Public Skateparks's Research and the website <u>skatepark.org</u>, who track skateboarding fatalities, 42 skateboarders died in 2011. 71 percent of the deaths involved or were directly caused by a vehicle, and the average age was 15 years old. These tragic accidents occurred during both day and night. Some involved texting or drunk drivers, while others were drivers who failed to see the skater in the street.

Skateboarders! Please use caution and stay safely on the side of the road. Drivers, please watch closely, they are everywhere!
