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CII Annual Homeowners Association Board Meeting Minutes, January 20, 2014

Location: Lake Forest Church, 8519 Gilead Road, Huntersville, NC 28078

The meeting was called to order at 7:10 PM and the previous Minutes were adopted.

<u>President's report</u> – As there were insufficient homeowners present to represent a quorum of 41 households, election of Officers was postponed until the February meeting when appointments will take place. Volunteers are encouraged to submit their names or names of others to Barrie for consideration. Two vacancies exist and current Board members Emily and Kevin have asked to be re-appointed.

The dues for 2014 will increase by \$5.00 per month, the first increase since a similar increase in 2010 and prior to that, 2003. The increase is needed to fund our Reserves Accounts for repairs and future amenities.

Emily thanked our volunteers with special appreciation to **Kevin Sweeney** for his annual Christmas lighting decoration and **Jen Wolfe** for the excellent Social Committee events held in 2013.

<u>Treasurer's report</u> – **Michael** presented a review of fiscal 2013 and the previously published and distributed 2014 Budget was adopted. He pointed out that the increase in dues for 2014 would pay for general emergencies, repairs to electric and plumbing as needed, higher rates for utilities, continued maintenance of the pool, pool furniture, pool house and gazebo, additional flower and bush planting and removal of overgrown bushes for reasons of safety.

<u>Committee reports</u> - Each summarized their list of projects completed in 2013 and 2014 planning.

<u>Pool</u> - **Kathy** and **Clarke** addressed the issue of Pool

entry control and how to enforce rules. They will meet with C-One representatives to modify both pools rules to result in a unified set of Entry Rules for 2014. Those rules will be conveyed to each communities swim management provider for incorporation and enforcement by the lifeguards. Also under review is the necessary compliance with the VGB Safety Drain requirements new for 2014.

<u>Landscape</u> – **Kevin** presented the plans for 2014 that include rain detector timers for the entry sprinkler systems, possible repellants for protection of plantings from deer, potential trimming or removal of the large holly bushes by the pool fence and other decorative new plantings provided by our landscape contractor.

<u>Social</u> – **Jennifer** and **Joanne** submitted a comprehensive review of the 2013 events with overall costs. The 2014 schedule will be packed with similar events such as Easter, Halloween, Softball Tournament, Movie Night, Yard Sales and even more with the expanded budget.

ARC – **Suzanne** and **Gary** have the task of approving the requests for building projects which may include painting, concrete work, shed installation and similar property improvements. The goal is to maintain a "harmonious" and "consistent" appearance in the C-Two neighborhood as well as requiring owners to maintain their property for the ongoing value that is added by proper upkeep.

<u>Cedarfield Sun</u> - The Cedarfield Sun now being produced by **Catherine Greenberg** will appear on the Web Site and in printed form by rquest. Suggestions for content and for potential new advertisers is welcomed as well as encouraging C2 homeowners to sign up for e-mails and the Cedarfield Sun.

<u>Hawthorne Mgt.</u> – **Barrie** closed the meeting agenda noting that there were only 5 hearings before the Board in 2013. Also, there were 26 new move-ins of which 23 were of private ownership.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:05 PM.



Tips for caring for your pets during winter months.

- Provide your pet with a thick, soft bed in a warm room on chilly nights
- Keep pets indoors as much as possible in cold weather. When they go out, stay with them. When you're cold enough to go in, your pet is probably ready to return inside too.
- Make sure they have plenty of non-frozen water to drink
- Your pet's health can also affect our long they can stay outdoors. Conditions like diabetes, heart disease, kidney disease and hormonal imbalances can compromise a pet's ability to regulate their own body heat.
- Very young and old animals are especially vulnerable to the cold. The cold can be especially hard on the joints of older animals that become stiff or tender.
- Rap on the hood of your car before you start your car or truck engine in the winter. A cold cat will curl up against almost anything including engines to stay warm.
- Provide warm shelter for your

animal if it has to be outside.

- Never leave a pet outside in below freezing temperatures.
- Huskies and similar long hairbreeds are better suited to the cold than short hair breeds.
