Originally established in 1885 in recognition of President George Washington, it is still officially called "Washington's Birthday" by the federal government. Traditionally celebrated on February 22—Washington's actual day of birth—the holiday became popularly known as Presidents' Day after it was moved as part of 1971's Uniform Monday Holiday Act, an attempt to create more three-day weekends for the nation's workers. While several states still have individual holidays honoring the birthdays of Washington, Abraham Lincoln and other figures, Presidents' Day is now popularly viewed as a day to celebrate all U.S. presidents past and present. This year we celebrate on Monday February 20th.



Guest introduction and discussion:

Officer Diaz has been assigned to our community as the liaison person with the Huntersville Police Department. Crime statistics for our area were discussed and our concerns with security at our community pool area were addressed. Larcenies from vehicles in our (and surrounding communities) are on the rise and residents are advised to make sure their vehicles are locked at all times and valuable items are not left out in plain sight. - The Board approved (5-0) the purchase of new playground mulch (20 yards) for 2017 which will be ordered prior to the pool opening in May (cost \$681.00 dollars). Residents will be notified of the "mulch spreading party" date.

Good and Welfare:

- The following are the combined scheduled parties/events with our sister HOAS' for 2017 Easter Egg Hunt, Halloween Party, Yard Sales.
- CPHOA will hold an Adult Only Luau Party this summer for its residents.
- Event dates and times have yet to be determined check our web site for additional details.

Pool:

- The Board approved (5-0) the renewal of our pool contract with RC's Pool Service, which expired December 31st, for a one year period with no increase in cost for 2017.
- The Board approved (5-0) the cost to clean the pool deck prior to our opening for the season estimates to be obtained.
- A security device at the pool is currently being evaluated and will be replaced if necessary.
- The pool is scheduled to open for the season Saturday, May 6, 2017 and will be operational WEEKENDS ONLY until the Memorial Day weekend May 27th and then open daily for the remainder of the season.

Tips for caring for your pets during winter months.

- Provide your pet with a thick, soft bed in a warm room on chilly nights
- Keep pets indoors as much as possible in cold weather. When they go out, stay with them. When you're cold enough to go in, your pet is probably ready to return inside too.
- Make sure they have plenty of non-frozen water to drink
- Your pet's health can also affect our long they can stay outdoors. Conditions like diabetes, heart disease, kidney disease and hormonal imbalances can compromise a pet's ability to regulate their own body heat.
- Very young and old animals are especially vulnerable to the cold. The cold can be especially hard on the joints of older animals that become stiff or tender.
- Rap on the hood of your car before you start your car or truck engine in the winter. A cold cat will curl up against almost anything including engines to stay warm.
- Provide warm shelter for your animal if it has to be outside.
- Never leave a pet outside in below freezing temperatures.
- Huskies and similar long hair breeds are better suited to the cold than short hair breeds.




Onyx is an all black adult cat. She is medium size and is very friendly! She likes to rub against your legs and loves to be scratched behind the ears!
