



More than a nuisance...it's hazardous!

Og waste is an environmental pollutant. In 1991, it was labeled a non-point source pollutant by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), placing it in the same category as herbicides and insecticides; oil, grease and toxic chemicals; and acid drainage from abandoned mines.

Did you know?

- Dogs don't digest proteins well. They pass them. Rats feed on this protein. Rat communities thrive. Nice.
- Dog waste is not fertilizer like other animal waste. It contains parasites. It should never be put in gardens and leaves brown spots on lawns.
- Pet droppings can contribute to diseases animals pass to humans, called zoonoses. Anyone who comes into contact with that soil—be it through gardening, playing sports, walking barefoot or any other means— especially your dog can become infected.
- Some of the hard-to-pronounce parasites your lawn could harbor include *Cryptosporidium*, *Giardia*, *Salmonella*, as well as hookworms, ringworms and tapeworms. Infections from these bugs often cause fever, muscle aches, headache, vomiting, and diarrhea in humans. Children are most susceptible, since they often play in the dirt and put things in their mouths or eyes.

The EPA discovered from a survey that 40 percent of the people who live in the area immediately surrounding the Chesapeake Bay—which experi-

enced significant pollution throughout much of the 1990s—did not pick up after their dogs because it was "too much work."

Others neglected to do so because they assumed it eventually goes away, or because the dog deposited the feces in an area far from the water, such as in the owner's yard or in the woods.

So, in essence, the cycle begins and ends with you. In one survey 44 percent of dog walkers who did not pick up after their dogs indicated they would still refuse to pick up—even if confronted by complaints from neighbors, threatened with fines, or provided with more sanitary and convenient options for retrieving and disposing of dog waste.

Please keep Cedarfield clean! Pick up after your dog.
