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Cedarfield Plantation Board Meeting Minutes for 4-2014

Attendance: Julie Taylor, Dave Rosen, William Saran, Gigi Glass, Margaret Doherty, Barrie Rojahn (Hawthorne Mgmt) Meeting called to order at 7:03pm and meeting was adjourned at 9:20pm. (Next Meeting: May 13th)

Homeowner Comments:

Homeowner requested the creation of a directory of residents and the mangement company will research possible solutons. Also, homeowner requested possible signage on the Greenway outlets, the Board to research options.

Treasury / Financial Report:

The March Financial Statement was not complete as of the meeting date. Barrie Rojahn with Hawthorne Management provided an overview of the pending March Financial Statement and an update of the delinquencies/violations reports.

Completed Projects:

The soil analysis collected by Heartwood on the oak trees at the pool house is complete and the Board will take the appropriate action to aid in the recovery of the trees.

The Board mailed the Spring Informational letter to all homeowners.

The Board added additional cameras at the pool area to improve overall coverage of the cameras.

The installation of Phase 1 for the shrubs/trees along the pool house drive and front entrance is complete.

The installation of pine needles by our landscape company is complete.

The Landscape Company has relocated a bench at the pond area and the bike rack to more usable areas.

The Board signed a new pool contract for 2014 and 2015 with Swim Club Management Group in Huntersville.

Outstanding Items:

The Board is currently working with our insurance company and contractors to review options for the repairs of the extensive freeze damage to the pool house.

The Board discussed the status of the Easter Egg Hunt Event scheduled for April 12th.

The Town of Huntersville is in progress for the modifications to the front grass areas on both sides of the road to improve drainage from McCoy Rd/Stratton Farm to the pool house drive.

The change to all light fixtures at monuments and accent lighting along the landscaping at front entrance is 90% complete.

The installation of lights along the pool house drive by Energy United is in progress.

An analysis of the irrigation system is currently in progress. The front entrance and pool section is complete.



The draft of the new pool policy is complete. The Board will approve and mail to all homeowners.

The Board approved a new pool key fob system, installation is scheduled for April 28th, a new key fob will be sent to all homeowners in the coming weeks along with the new pool policy.

The installation of Phase 2 for the shrubs/trees along Stratton Farm Parkway including the monument area is in progress.

The Board approved money to have the trees at Twin Trail pruned.

The Board will get a bid to have additional pruning completed near the pool/pond area.

The Board will work with Landscape Company to set up a fertilizer treatment for the oak trees down the pool house drive.

The Board is finalizing the addition of WIFI at the pool area; installation should be completed within a few weeks.

The Board is in discussions to move the marquee board in the island of Twin Trail to a more visible area.

The Board agreed to design new signs to be placed in all marquee locations.

The Welcome Committee will create a "Welcome Packet" for all new homeowners in Cedarfield.

The meeting was called to order at 7:03 PM and the previous Minutes were adopted.

President's Report – Our President, Kevin LaValley stated that with the agreement of the Board, Michael Rumble will assume the role of Board Vice President. Ray Kudlak will re-assume the role of Treasurer until a Treasurer is appointed. Ray will continue as Secretary.

<u>Pool</u> - **Kevin** reported that our **Insurance coverage** for the Playground, Pool House and Pool Equipment has been raised at our request. // **Protective drain covers** to meet the new VGB requirements have been installed. // **Revised Pool Rules** have been drafted and are being circulated to CI and Cedarfield Plantation for feedback as well as the Pool Committee of CII. These will be communicated prior to the opening of the Pool once a final version is agreed upon.

<u>Landscape</u> – New **Rain Detector Timers** for the entry monument sprinkler systems have been installed and **pine Needles**, removal of the large **holly bushes** by

the pool fence has been completed. // Decorative ferns or rose bushes for the pool surroundings are being provided by our landscape contractor. // The balance of **Split Rail Fencing** also has been removed at the Stratton Farm / McIlwayne entrance. // The **Creek Bed** at the common area has been cleaned out to allow for mowing and trimming by our landscaper. // **Overgrown grasses** along McIlwayne has also been trimmed back. // A "NO TRESPASSING" sign has been ordered and will be installed at the Duke Energy easement and the property owner has said that he will contact Duke Energy for requesting that a gate be installed at the entrance.


