Thanksgiving is a great time for family and friends! Quite often there is way too much food, a whole lot of football, kids playing, Uncles getting a bit too tipsy and maybe even an Aunt who, if at all possible, needs to be kept away from the Egg Nog! What a wonderful and special time when most of us

stop and reflect on what it is that we have to be thankful for. There are some fun family games that help everyone, even the youngest, articulate those things that they are thankful for...like ...

- ABC's: have everyone go around the table, starting with the letter A, and say something that they are thankful for that begins with that letter...continue all the way to Z. *(It is fun to see what they think of that starts with q or x!)*
- * Thankful Envelope. Every year, have the children (or all family members) write down five things for which they're thankful next to their name and the date. This year, consider being especially thankful for what you have to give, rather than only being thankful for all you have received. Remember those for whom this holiday season may be especially difficult because of loss. Consider opening your hearts and home to someone, or some family, who could use a day of food, fun and laughter.



A REMINDER AS FALL APPROACHES...

Residents are allowed 5 bags of yard debris during regular months and up to 10 bags during heavy leaf season (November 1 - January 15). Bags must be clear or transparent and no larger than 25 gallon. From January 15 through October 31st, Advanced Disposal will



collect up to 5 bags. Residents may also use opaque bags as long as they are left open. Plastic bags are not allowed in the yard waste rollout.

Tips for caring for your pets during winter months.

- Provide your pet with a thick, soft bed in a warm room on chilly nights
- Keep pets indoors as much as possible in cold weather. When they go
 out, stay with them. When you're cold enough to go in, your pet is
 probably ready to return inside too.
- Make sure they have plenty of non-frozen water to drink
- Your pet's health can also affect our long they can stay outdoors. Conditions like diabetes, heart disease, kidney disease and hormonal imbalances can compromise a pet's ability to regulate their own body heat.
- Very young and old animals are especially vulnerable to the cold. The cold can be especially hard on the joints of older animals that become stiff or tender.
- Rap on the hood of your car before you start your car or truck engine in the winter. A cold cat will curl up against almost anything including engines to stay warm.
- Provide warm shelter for your animal if it has to be outside.
- Never leave a pet outside in below freezing temperatures.
- Huskies and similar long hair breeds are better suited to the cold than short hair breeds.





Be sure to listen to your instincts. When something doesn't look right, call the HPD. Keep our community and neighbor's safe.

CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET

A couple of notes for our residents:

Fall is the perfect time to get our yard in shape. Here are a few helpful tips:

- Aerate, seed, and fertilize your lawn (this will help with any bare spots). Once you seed and fertilize wait a couple of weeks before you mow again...give the seedlings time to grow securely into the soil!
- Promptly remove any dead plant material located on the lot.
- Regularly mow (about every 10 days during the growing season); <u>edge</u> along curbs, walkways, and drive ways; and remove weeds growing in cracks in the driveway, weeds growing in the curb, and in the landscape beds.
- Tall Fescue lawns should be mowed to a height of 2 1/2 to 3 1/2 inchesIf your shrubs or trees need pruning, now is a good time to get them in shape.
- Installation of pine needles or mulch of choice to landscape beds will add the finishing touch to beds that are lacking ground cover or just need a fresh application.



No matter what it is called, the reason for observing the day is the same - To show our **gratitude** to the brave men and women who sacrifice everything to make this world a safer place for the rest of us.
