



The only enforcement that can be issued is by the County/Town Code Enforcement or Police when vehicles are blocking right of ways. Parking in a CII yard or on the grass area between sidewalks & street is a HOA violation and the HOA board should be contacted so Hawthorne Management can mail out the appropriate violations letters.
- Hawthorne Management will mail several letters to homeowners that violate the HOA covenant regarding commercial markings on vehicles.

Landscaping

- All holly bushes have been trimmed around pool and leaking sprinkler head fixed on Henderson Hill.



Subject: Henderson Hill Road Speed Study

Cedarfield II HOA:

The Engineering & Public Works Department conducted a speed study for <u>Henderson Hill Road</u> in response to the traffic calming request received February 20, 2017. A speed study was conducted at two locations in June of 2017 via radar data collector. Below is a summary of the speed study results.

Location #1 (near Cedar Hollow Ln) 15th Percentile Speed: 16mph 50th Percentile Speed: 23mph **85th Percentile Speed: 29mph** 95th Percentile Speed: 32mph Mean Speed (Average): 23mph 10 MPH Pace Speed : 21-30 MPH Average Daily Traffic: 296 vehicles Location #2 (near Pine Springs Ct) 15th Percentile Speed: 18mph 50th Percentile Speed: 23mph **85th Percentile Speed: 28mph** 95th Percentile Speed: 32mph Mean Speed (Average): 24mph 10 MPH Pace Speed : 21-30 MPH Average Daily Traffic: 357 vehicles

To be eligible for continuation in the study for traffic calming devices on this street, the Town of Huntersville's traffic calming policy requires that a street must have an 85th percentile speed greater than 5 MPH over the posted speed limit to qualify. This equates to 31mph for a street posted at 25 MPH.

Considering that the Town's Neighborhood Traffic Calming Policy requires the speed threshold be met, and given that the 85th percentile speed was below the minimum requirements, it is Engineering and Public Works' position that traffic calming is not warranted at this time. It is our policy to wait a minimum of 1-year before a secondary study be performed. Please continue to provide information to your community about driving safely.


