



### CII ANNUAL HOA BOARD MEETING

**January 8, 2018** 

In attendance: Debra Lemmon (President), Jerry Goedert (Vice-President), Josh Dumas (Treasurer), Addy Barton (Member at Large), Ryan Wilson (Secretary), Dagney Helms (Hawthorne Mgmt Representative). Six additional community households present – a quorum was not able to be established (41 lots needed).

#### COMMITTEE REPORTS

- Pool Committee A review of the current fob system is underway by the Pool Committee to eliminate
  excess pool fobs in circulation. As a reminder, there is a no overnight parking policy in place at the C2 pool.
  Any vehicles parked overnight will be towed at the Owner's expense. If additional overnight parking is
  needed, contact a Board Member for approval.
- ARC Committee Any changes to property must be approved by the CII ARC committee. The purpose of
  the approval process is to ensure property changes & improvements conform to the existing architectural
  tone of the community as set forth by the Covenants, Conditions, & Restrictions set forth by the HOA. The
  ARC request form can be located under the documents tab on the CII website (www.cedarfieldii.com).
- Social Committee The Cedarfield Christmas festival held in December was very successful. Although a
  combined event with CI, CII picked up the entire cost of the event which totaled \$4,000. The next
  anticipated Social Event will be Easter Weekend. The Social Committee continues to seek volunteers. If

- Landscaping/Maintenance Committee The Board is currently looking into options for cleaning up the creek bed in the power line right-of-way area. The bed is part of the area watershed boundaries and we are looking for assistance from the Town to ensure cleanup is handled properly. The current C2 playground has been closed indefinitely due to major structural and safety concerns. The Board is currently working to find replacement options that are up to current safety codes & regulations.

#### FINANCIAL REPORT

Cedarfield II is finishing 2017 within budget, with a slight surplus due to unanticipated SUN advertisement sales, paid HOA late fees, & various other means. The 2018 budget has been approved and is very comparable to the 2017 budget. Some homes have prepaid excess amounts of HOA dues; homes with excess paid amounts at the end of the 2018 dues cycle will be reimbursed back to the homeowners. \$15 late fee will continue to be assessed for late HOA payments.

Due to a quorum not being established, the Board appointed Abby Barton for an additional term as the Board Member at Large, through 2019.



### Tips for caring for your pets during winter months.

Provide your pet with a thick, soft bed in a warm room on chilly nights

☐ Keep pets indoors as much as possible in cold weather. When they go out, stay with them. When you're cold enough to go in, your pet is probably ready to return inside too.

 $\ \square$  Make sure they have plenty of non-frozen water to drink

☐ Your pet's health can also affect our long they can stay out-doors. Conditions like diabetes, heart disease, kidney disease and hormonal imbalances can compromise a pet's ability to regulate their own body heat.

 $\hfill \square$  Very young and old animals are especially vulnerable to the cold. The cold can be especially hard on the

joints of older animals that become stiff or tender.

□ Rap on the hood of your car before you start your car or truck engine in the winter. A cold cat will curl up against almost any-thing including engines to stay warm.

☐ Provide warm shelter for your animal if it has to be outside.

□ Never leave a pet outside in below freezing temperatures.

☐ Huskies and similar long hair-breeds are better suited to the cold than short hair breeds.






