

It's the Law:

Mecklenburg County Surface Water Pollution Control Ordinance

Section 4. Prohibited Discharges to the Storm Drain System.

- (a) Illicit discharges prohibited. No person shall cause any non-storm water flow to enter the storm drain system unless listed in Section 4(d).
- (b) Installation or use of illicit connections prohibited. No person shall install, maintain or use any connection to the storm drain system for the discharge of non-storm water or shall cause non-storm water to be discharged or conveyed through a connection to the storm drain system unless the discharge consists entirely of storm water or is an allowable discharge listed in Section 4(d).
- (c) Improper disposal prohibited. No person shall cause any refuse, rubbish, food waste, garbage, litter, paint, paint wash water, chlorinated swimming pool water, oil, grease, household, industrial and chemical materials, leaves, grass clippings, dead plants, animal matter, animal waste or any other discarded or abandoned substances or waste materials to be disposed of in a storm drain system or at a location from which the substances could be transported to the storm drain system.





FINANCIAL REPORT

Want a beautiful lawn this year?

Now is the time to apply pre-emergent!

Early March is the time to apply pre-emergent herbicides to lawns in southeastern North Carolina. These products are usually applied as a granular and then watered in to the lawn. If your summer lawn is typically weedy, applying a pre-emergent now could help reduce summer weeds, depending on the type of weeds you have and the health of your lawn.

To be effective, pre-emergent products must be applied before seeds of summer weeds sprout, which usually happens around the time dogwoods begin to bloom. Applying a pre-emergent now will ensure the product is in place before weed seeds start to sprout. The downside of using pre-emergent herbicides is that they stunt root growth on turf grasses. In a healthy, vigorous lawn the impact is usually not serious, but on a lawn that is already struggling, the effect can be severe.

Before applying your pre-emergent, mow the lawn shorter than usual, apply pre-emergent then plan on fertilizing for a lush hearty lawn this summer. Remember that Tall Fescue lawns need to be moved to 2-3" heights to protect the roots and keep the lawn hearty!




