COMMITTEE REPORTS

- ARC Committee Request for a lap pool was submitted for approval and approved. Property inspections are
 completed monthly with notices sent out to homeowners who are in violation of CII ARC guidelines. To make an

- Reminder to address lawns; cut yards & treat for weeds as needed.
- Social Committee The Social Committee continues to seek additional help and participation from neighborhood residents. If interested, contact Jessica Shellenberger at jess_gillette@yahoo.com. The following are the planned summer events:

- Pool Committee 2018 pool rules and information was mailed to all CII homeowners. Those CII homeowners who
 are delinquent in dues have had their pool fobs deactivated. The pool will open on May 19th. The kiddie pool is
 currently not operable due to a malfunction with the pump. Swim Club Management hopes to have the pump fixed
 before opening day.
- Landscaping Committee Grass cutting through our vendor continues to occur. Pine straws in place prior to pool
 opening. Grass cutting in field planned to be cut weekly. Working with Duke to trim crape myrtles at Stratton Farm
 because they're in the powerline right of ways.
- Playground The playground is still in progress. We are waiting for a site survey to be completed to determine any
 setbacks or right of ways that must be observed. Based on homeowner feedback, the board is looking at replacing the
 proposed new swing area with playground equipment that has more movement. The board is also looking to have the
 grills relocated a few feet from the current location, allowing more room for the new playground footprint.
- Financial Report Financial report available at the time of the meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

- The Board began initial discussions about the process to change the CCRs to be more updated to current times &
 modern designs. Additionally, discussions were had about the number of rental properties in the neighborhood &
 averages allowed in similar size & type neighborhoods.

- The Board approved changes to the current "limited enforcement" collection policy, changing the terms from 90 days past due to 60 days past due. The policy states that Hawthorne Management will engage an attorney for the purpose of filing a lien to record amounts owed to the association by the owner which are at least 60 days past due. It is understood that once forwarded to the attorney's office, the attorney is authorized and instructed to file a lien but take no other actions until further instructions are received from the board of directors in order to collect amounts owed.

Finance Report:

- As of May 16th, all accounts should be PAID IN FULL. Late fees for all outstanding balances for 2018 will be assessed on June 1st, and the 15th of each month thereafter.
- We have approximately \$50,000 in outstanding accounts.

Committee Reports:

<u>Architectural</u> – No updates. The committee is current on all requests. <u>Landscaping</u>

- Committee has 3 members and are planning to meet soon. Would still like 1 more member. Contact Ben Barbour if interested. <u>treasur-er@cedarfieldplantation1.com</u>
- Motion with second to accept quote from Jason Huffstickler for removal of Leyland cypresses on pool side of road between pool boulevard and Cedar Fall Drive in July 2018 for \$20,000, including removal and pulling of stumps. All in favor; motion passed.
- Replacing trees:
- Quote from Jason Huffstickler Quote is for Green Giants and includes adding a magnolia for the corner of pool boulevard to match the other corner, and 3 maple type trees along pool boulevard. Price also includes treating the soil. \$23,000
- Quote from Superior Landscaping They recommend varying the trees so if disease hits, it won't take out the whole row. Their cost will include irrigation for new trees, adding a magnolia for the corner of pool boulevard to match the other corner, and trees to plant along pool boulevard. Price still to come.
- The board decided to table this discussion until the June meeting, so that more information and quotes can be presented.
- Superior quote for sprucing up monuments at front entrance Replace the shrubs so the monument areas match each other, add more perennial flowers, take out pine needles and add mulch instead for a different look. Total cost is \$5220. Motion with second to approve this quote; all in favor; motion passed. Ben will check with Superior to see if they will guarantee the new plantings. Ben will contact Superior to tell them to get started as soon as possible.
- Superior quote for pine needles at front and along pool boulevard, and at all monument areas. Total cost is \$5,950. Motion with second to approve this quote; all in favor; motion passed. Ben will contact Superior to tell them to get started as soon as possible.
- Superior quote from 2017 to fix irrigation issues. Motion with second to approve this quote as long as it doesn't exceed \$2500. All in favor; motion passed. 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
