- Pool Committee The HOA board and the twelve homeowners present at the meeting discussed the proposed changes to the 2018 pool hours. The board had proposed changing the hours from 11a-9p to 10a-8p. After an open discussion, the following ideas were proposed by those in attendance: Mon, Tues, Wed 11a-8p, Thurs, Fri, Sat, Sun 10-9; cut pre-Memorial Day & post-Labor Day hours; "At very least," leave open until 9p Thurs, Fri, Sat, Sun 10a-9p; Direct C1 join funds directly to pool (\$75 per membership); Mon-Thurs 11a-8p ----- Fri, Sat, Sun 10a-9p; Open at 10a a couple times of week, not daily, after swim team season is over, leave pool open until 9p. Following the meeting, the board took the proposed suggestions to Swim Club Management to discuss the budget implications. After a thorough review of all the options and contract rates, the board unanimously decided on the following pool hours for the 2018 season: Sat-Sun 10a-9p; Mon-Wed 11a-8p; Thur-Fri 11a-9p (after swim team season, hours change to 10a-9p Thur-Fri). After the pool opens and before Memorial Day, the pool will be closed Monday through Friday and open Saturday and Sunday from 10a-9p. The Friday of Memorial Day Weekend, the pool will be open from 4p-8p. After Memorial Day, on weekdays when public school is in session, the pool will be closed Monday through Thursday and open Friday from 4p-8p. On Labor Day, the pool will be open from 10a-9p. The annual cost for the amended contract will be \$35,911.
- Landscaping Committee Flowers will only be planted at the monuments once in 2018. This is a change from
 previous years, in accordance with the landscaping contract. Fresh pine needles will be placed at the monuments and
 common areas in May. There has been a recent cleanup of the natural areas along Stratton Farm and planned cleanup
 of debris near the monuments will take place soon.
- Playground The playground rebuild is still a work in progress. The old playground structure has been removed due to safety hazards. The HOA Board is working with Hawthorne Management to complete a site survey in the area where the new playground is slated to be installed. Once the site survey is complete, the HOA Board will move forward with vendor selection and final design schematics. The playground project may be completed in stages, with future enhancements added in 2019-2020. Once a contract is signed, design plans will be posted to the Cedarfield II website and information will be included in the Cedarfield Sun Newsletter. Visit www.cedarfieldii.com for updates and further information.
- Financial Report We continue to take in yearly HOA dues through June. Some homes have prepaid excess amounts
 of HOA dues; homes with excess paid amounts at the end of the 2018 dues cycle will be reimbursed back to the
 homeowners. A \$15 late fee will continue to be assessed for late HOA payments.







Questions from the floor:

What is the plan for the leylands? We are currently working on a plan for the leylands on Stratton Farm between the pool road and Cedar Fall, on the pool side of the road. There are 87 trees that were flagged for estimates. Those estimates are coming in around \$30,000-\$35,000 just to take them down.

Can we plant new trees before taking out old? This is not an option.

Does cost include stump grinding? Yes.

Does cost include improving the ground? No.

What about irrigation for any new trees that are planted? We've spoken with our landscapers about putting in an irrigation drip line.

What about irrigating the trees that were planted along McCoy Road when the road was moved? We have not done anything because getting irrigation back there is tough.

We are considering forming a Leyland Committee.

Question about the budget and dues – is \$205,200 income 100% of dues collected? Yes. Tracey Griffin (Cedar Management) went over collections process.

What is involved with the pond maintenance? We have a company currently managing the pond. We will have this company have a representative attend a meeting soon to inform us of everything they do.

What is the Landscaping other line item in the budget? Extras (pine needles, flowers, etc.) and emergencies (tree removal).

We did not reach a quorum, so no vote was held for new board members. The current board will appoint someone from the list of homeowners who were interested in serving.

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
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
