



### HOA MEETING AGENDA October 10, 2018

Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm

In attendance: Debra Lemmon (President); Jerry Goedert (Vice President); Addy Barton (Member at Large); Ryan Wilson (Secretary); Kevin LaValley (Landscape Committee); three CII homeowners

Motion with second to ratify the September minutes - all in favor, motion passed.

#### OLD BUSINESS

- Angel Oak monument water bill: The bill for this location (8907 Stratton Farm) is for irrigation only at the monument. The bill decreased from \$159.03 in August to \$112.04 in September because the irrigation system was turned off. This monument falls within the CI boundary. Motion with second was passed to hand off this monument maintenance and water bill to CI. CII President will discuss with CI.
- Stratton Farm monument water leak: The leak is the responsibility of the City of Huntersville base on work they completed on the water main July 23<sup>rd</sup>. The city is aware that there is still an issue and yard damage needs to be addressed. Per the city, service orders are scheduled based on priority and since this repair will need an entire crew, they have been unable to schedule a follow-up repair. Hawthorne Management will follow-up with the city of the repair timeline. For future reference, the City can only locate this repair info in their system if we use the address of 11900 Henderson Hill.

#### OFFICER REPORTS

- TREASURER REPORT: No unexpected expenses in September. Two past due homes paid in full for a total of \$725. There are still 14 homes that have past due balances totaling \$8,454.06 to. Total assets (cash + reserves) are about \$12,000 under what they were at this point last year, which can be mostly attributed to the down payment on the playground. Given that we still have another payment to come, we will be finishing 2018 well below where we were at the end of 2017.
- PRESIDENT REPORT: Nothing to report.

#### COMMITTEE REPORTS

- SWIM TEAM: Nothing to report.
- ARC COMMITTEE: Only one ARC request submitted in September that was approved for exterior paint color change. The October community inspection found: 13 violations for the prior month were corrected; 39 new violations were reported (21 for mold); 44 final notices were mailed to homeowners; 8 violation hearings will be scheduled; of the total violations reported, 16 were from rental properties.
- SOCIAL COMMITTEE Next event fall festival on October 27<sup>th</sup>. Expenses split with CI.
- POOL COMMITTEE Swim Club Management provide off-season maintenance list. Total cost for repairs, \$12,533. CII President will circle back with SCM to determine what repairs are necessary and what repairs might be able to wait. Pool FOB use for the 2018 season was discussed. A more detailed discussion will take place in the coming months.
- LANDSCAPING COMMITTEE Aeration and overseeding completed. Creek bed and pruning to commence in Oct.-Nov.



## **Signs Your Dog Is Cold!**

Knowing when your dog is cold is key to keeping them comfy and healthy in the winter months. Here are four signs your dog is cold:

- **Hunched and Bunched:** Like us, when dogs are trying to conserve body heat they scrunch up their bodies. They pull their head down, their tail under and they arch their backs. "Miserable" is the caption. Get them inside where it is warm immediately!
- **Shaking:** Like us, dogs tremble and shiver in an effort to get warmer. Some small dogs tremble when nervous as well, so know your dog. But if your dog doesn't normally shake and he is shaking and it's cold? Assume he IS cold. When in doubt, assume he is cold.
- Lifting One Paw Then Another: Cold dogs stand on three feet then shift to lift another paw off the ground. This can also be a sign that salt is stinging their feet. Either way, they are uncomfortable.
- **Doesn't Stretch:** Because they are trying to conserve body heat, they don't stretch when they get up from sleeping or come out of a dog house

It is 100% up to us to keep our dogs safe and comfortable year round. If your dog must stay outside in cold weather then get them an insulated dog house that is up to the task! Do not rely on dog coats or sweaters for outside dogs as they can slip off or get wet.


