HOA MEETING AGENDA

November 14, 2018

Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm

In attendance: Debra Lemmon (President); Jerry Goedert (Vice President); Addy Barton (Member at Large) Motion with second to ratify the October minutes - all in favor, motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS

- Angel Oak monument water bill: The CI HOA will take over the monument irrigation and water bills.
- Stratton Farm monument water leak: The leak is the responsibility of the City of Huntersville base on work they completed on the water main July 23rd. The city is aware that there is still an issue and yard damage needs to be addressed. Hawthorne Management will follow-up with the city of the repair timeline. For future reference, the city can only locate this repair info in their system if we use the address of 11900 Henderson Hill.
- The Stratton Farm monument spotlight has been fixed.

OFFICER REPORTS

- TREASURER REPORT: No unexpected items to report. There has been a small increase in our legal expenses due to our activity with past due homes, but we are still well under the budgeted amount for the year. We had one home with a large past due balance (\$575.00) pay us after we sent notification of pending lien. Final playground invoice was paid and applied to playground reserve which is now \$16,405 in the red. The board approved the 2019 budget. Information about the budget will be mailed to homeowners in November. There will be an increase in annual dues associated to increases in electricity, water/sewer, insurance and management fees. The increase in dues will also shore up reserve funds and assist with any future capital projects should the need arise.
- PRESIDENT REPORT: Nothing to report.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

- SWIM TEAM: Nothing to report.
- ARC COMMITTEE: No new requests received. In October, the board held hearings for homeowner violations that were 90 days past due. Of the 10 hearings scheduled, no homeowners attended. As a result, each owner was assessed a one-time fine and then charged a weekly fine imposed until the violations are resolved. An additional 19 hearings are scheduled for November 28th for the violations issued from the November inspection.
- SOCIAL COMMITTEE Fall festival was a success. Next event Holiday party in December.
- POOL COMMITTEE The board approved \$3,439 in off-season maintenance work to the pool main drains, pump seals and pool cover anchors. Additional work totaling \$8,870 is suggested by Swim Club Management to be completed prior to the spring. The board needs to provide a decision on these items by the end of February for the work to be completed before the pool opens. The board will have further discussion on these items at the Dec.-Jan. board meetings.
- LANDSCAPING COMMITTEE Pruning and pine needle application will be completed prior to Thanksgiving.

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
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

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Tips for caring for your pets during winter months.

- Provide your pet with a thick, soft bed in a warm room on chilly nights
- Keep pets indoors as much as possible in cold weather. When they go out, stay with them. When you're cold enough to go in, your pet is probably ready to return inside too.
- Make sure they have plenty of non-frozen water to drink
- Your pet's health can also affect our long they can stay outdoors.
 Conditions like diabetes, heart disease, kidney disease and hormonal imbalances can compromise a pet's ability to regulate their own body heat.
- Very young and old animals are especially vulnerable to the cold.
 The cold can be especially hard on the joints of older animals that become stiff or tender.
- Rap on the hood of your car before you start your car or truck engine in the winter. A cold cat will curl up against almost anything including engines to stay warm.
- Provide warm shelter for your animal if it has to be outside.
- <u>Never</u> leave a pet outside in below freezing temperatures.
- Huskies and similar long hair breeds are better suited to the cold than short hair breeds.


