Solstice Facts & Folklore

SUMMER IS HERE!



The first day of summer 2019 arrives this month with the solstice on Friday, June 21st at 11:54 a.m. EDT. For those of us in the Northern Hemisphere, this marks the longest day of the year and the moment when the Sun reaches the Tropic of Cancer, its highest point. The solstice happens at the same moment for everyone, everywhere on Earth.

The term "solstice" comes from the Latin words sol (sun) and sistere (to stand still). At the solstice, the angle between the Sun's rays and the plane of the Earth's equator (called declination) appears to stand still. This phenomenon is most noticeable at the Arctic Circle where the Sun hugs the horizon for a continuous 24 hours, thus the term "Land of the Midnight Sun."

The summer solstice has long been celebrated by cultures around the world: In Ancient Egypt, the summer solstice coincided with the rising of the Nile River. As it was crucial to predict this annual flooding, the Egyptian New Year began at this important solstice. In centuries past, the Irish would cut hazel branches on Solstice eve to be used in searching for gold, water, and precious jewels. Many European cultures hold Midsummer celebrations at the solstice, which include gatherings at Stonehenge and the lighting of bonfires on hilltops...

- 1. SWIM IN DESIGNATED AREAS SUPERVISED BY LIFEGUARDS.
- 2. ALWAYS SWIM WITH A BUDDY; DO NOT ALLOW ANYONE TO SWIM ALONE.
- 3. NEVER LEAVE A YOUNG CHILD UNATTENDED NEAR WATER AND DO NOT TRUST A CHILD'S LIFE TO ANOTHER CHILD; TEACH CHILDREN TO ALWAYS ASK PERMISSION TO GO NEAR WATER.
- 4. AVOID DISTRACTIONS WHEN SUPERVISING CHILDREN AROUND WATER.
- 5. IF A CHILD IS MISSING, CHECK THE WATER FIRST. SECONDS COUNT IN PREVENTING DEATH OR DISABILITY.
- 6. MAINTAIN CONSTANT SUPERVISION.
- 7. PROTECT YOUR SKIN. LIMIT THE AMOUNT OF DIRECT SUNLIGHT YOU RECEIVE BETWEEN 10:00 A.M. AND 4:00 P.M. AND WEAR SUNSCREEN WITH A PROTECTION FACTOR OF AT LEAST 15.
- 8. HAVE YOUNG CHILDREN OR INEXPERIENCED SWIMMERS WEAR U.S. COAST GUARD-APPROVED LIFE JACKETS AROUND WATER, BUT DO NOT RELY ON LIFE JACKETS ALONE.
- 9. MAKE SURE EVERYONE IN YOUR FAMILY LEARNS TO SWIM WELL. ENROLL IN AGE-APPROPRIATE WATER ORIENTATION AND LEARN-TO-SWIM COURSES.

MARBLED MUG INSTRUCTIONS:

Fill the container halfway with hot water. Pour a drop or two of polish into the water at close range to aid in drops staying on the surface rather than sinking. Quickly swirl with toothpick. Dip your mug into the water, staying below the lip line. Place mug on paper towel, upside down to dry. Use nail polish remover for any excess or clean up. Let sit overnight before using. Hand wash your mug and avoid using in the microwave.

Motion with second to ratify April Regular Session Minutes; all in favor. Motion Passed

FINANCE REPORT:

- Reserves balance: \$78,648
- · Operating budget balance: \$86,487
- About to pay final check for the pool, between \$45-50K
- We will Maintain 20% operating budget in reserves
- \$40K in prepaid accounts
- Current outstanding: \$51,860 in unpaid dues & fees, through May 1 billing
 - ¼ of homeowners have not paid their dues

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Landscaping:

- We are working on leak an Twin Trail at Stratton Farm;
- Hollies on Cedar Fall & Stratton Farm:
 - Proposal is either pay for crane to shape holly 3x per year
 - Or cut it down to manageable height; ugly while growing in

Social:

- Pool opens May 25
- · Memorial Day party on May 27, BBQ plates, starts at 11, first come, first served

Pool:

- Wouldn't have been able to open the pool this year without repairs
- Spent about \$90K on repairs: New coping, tile, fiberglass and gel coat, added handrail to baby pool
- Deck has been pressure washed, furniture is being cleaned
- Updated Pool rules have been sent out
 - Lifeguards are in charge and can ask people to leave
 - No hard balls, except volleyball in designated area, allowed
- Adult swim at 8am 10am
 - Adults only
 - We have 5 volunteers who will open the pool each day
- New weekend hours:
 - Saturday and Sunday open at 10am, including holidays July 4 and 5th
- Later start date: Memorial Day
- Should we purchase AED machine?
 - \$3-5K for the equipment
 - HOA would have to Save that expense for next year, but homeowners volunteered to raise funds

- · 10% or about 48 observed for this month's inspection, but board still reviewing before they are issued
- · Property management group observes and reports violations, not the Board

HUNTERSVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT PRESENTATION:

Solicitors

- Homeowners can ask people to leave

CEDARFIELD II HOA BOARD MEETING MINUTES

May 8, 2019 Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm

IN ATTENDANCE: Jerry Goedert (Vice President); Josh Dumas (Treasure & ARC Committee), Sue Patrick (Hawthorne Management), 1 Homeowner.

Motion with second to ratify the April minutes - all in favor, motion passed.

OFFICER REPORTS:

TREASURER REPORT:

Expenses were as expected in April. There were two months' worth of invoices for landscaping, but that brings us up to budgeted amount for the year. Also, a large pool contract invoice was paid. Lights and other maintenance items at the pool was another large expense. Several homes that had growing outstanding 2019 assessment balances paid in April. There are still several that remain delinquent. Nevertheless, we are in a much healthier position than last year, with total past due assessments being almost 25% lower in 2019.

PRESIDENT REPORT: No Presidents report this month.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

- ARC Committee: 5 requests were reviewed and approved, 1 request was received and denied.
- Social Committee: If you are interested in joining the team, we are still in search of a couple more volunteers.
- Pool Committee: Pool rules went out in a mailing, and committee is getting the pool ready for season opening.
- Landscape/Maintenance: Seasonal planting and pine straw starts tomorrow May 9 th. Needed to finish irrigation repairs before planting flowers. We will be testing a new ground cover material instead of pine needles at the pool. If it is well received, we will look at using it in other common areas and entryways. Creek bed maintenance has been under way and it is looking much better. Stratton Farm entrance at McIlwaine will be modified and thinned to approve overall appearance and aesthetics. Drainage issue at common area trail behind pool - spoke with homes that are piling leaves and debris and asked them to help keep the area clean. Drainage pipe was clogged with gravel and has been partially cleaned. Charlotte Mecklenburg Utility (CMUD) is putting together a report and recommendation for repair. Will get quotes on repair options. Homeowner complaints were communicated to James for him to address with his employees.
