

MEETING MINUTES (poolhouse)

September 9, 2021

Call Meeting to Order at 7:05pm

OFFICER REPORTS

<u>Treasurer Report</u>: Higher legal fees this month because of having attys review and advise on CCR updates; foreclosure on one house due to lack of HOA dues payment.

<u>President's Report</u>: Updated FB with final reach-out re: CCR changes. Responded to everybody with positive response and ask for help to get friends/homeowners to vote when ballots come out. Have until first week of October to get ballots back. Met with new C1 President and Vice-President (Brian Summers and Pat Beare).

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- DOR changes: Attys final documents separated the rental limitation
 - Voting initiative: homeowner would like to offer an incentive for 2 households in a random drawing (2 \$100 gift cards for first 150 ballots); HOA board excluded from drawing.
 - End of Summer/turn in ballot event September 26th Food Truck. Minimum of \$700 revenue for food truck. Average plates are \$10 per plate. About 70 people needed to hit minimum of any of the trucks. Plated Palette (Greek/tacos) 4-6pm. Free ice cream from ice cream truck for residents. Sign boards posted for ballots.
 - Use Street Captains on Sept. 27th to get votes out if needed.
- Estimates on poolhouse renovations quotes- (1) Savoy Construction Co. \$50,000 to do poolhouse reno; (2) Honey-Do Services ~\$37,700+; (3) Aaron Wilson Handyman Services \$33,500+, sub for electrical and millwork (countertops and cabinetry) separately. Not willing to be GC.
 - Need 4 new circuits for each electric hand dryers. Pod rented for pool furniture storage during reno.
- Meeting room renovation quotes- Savoy Construction Co. meeting room addition (\$184,000, could go down
 when they get structural blueprints). Meeting room would go behind the guard station for rental to all
 Cedarfield residents. Would have plumbing/toilets.
- Code of Conduct for Committee Chairs- tabled until January & will be part of the onboarding process

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Landscape: Dearness Gardens for updates to monument landscaping, up to \$1000 for a design plan.

Welcome: no report

<u>Social:</u> C1 & C2 event Falloween 10/2 with 10/9 rain date at C2 pool parking lot and field- will have DJ, pumpkins to give away, photobooth, refreshments, activities *need volunteers* Hula Hoop contest, Scavenger Hunt, Costume Bingo (find someone who...), Costume contest by age groups (gift card prizes, etc), Raffle for adults, Make Your Own Smores.
